



SAT or ACT REQUIREMENTS

As a general rule, students who hold the IB diploma, the EB diploma or a European secondary school diploma that grants access to university, do not need to take the SAT or ACT.

Students who obtained a diploma of secondary education in a country not listed here, may be required to submit SAT or ACT scores. In order to determine whether or not you are required to submit SAT or ACT scores, please contact our [Admissions Office](#) which will provide you with further guidance.

For applicants who must take either the SAT or ACT test here are the addresses and instructions for sending scores:

<p>BA Minimum score: SAT: The accepted minimum scores are <u>1100/1600</u> (Math <u>550/800</u>, Evidence-Based Reading and Writing <u>550/800</u>).</p>	<p>BA Minimum score: ACT: The accepted minimum score is <u>25/36</u> composite score (English <u>25/36</u>, Math <u>25/36</u>).</p>
